

When collecting and storing personal information from you Keyweb AG follows strict security procedures in accordance with the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and the German Telemedia Act (TMG). We assure you that your data will be handled strictly confidential and in accordance with current data protection regulations.

Your personal data are only saved for the intended purposes of processing the order, initiating and fulfilling the contract, and for invoicing and contacting you. The data gathered are only processed and used in as far as is necessary and in as far as you have consented to sending you product information, making you a service offer or for the purpose of gathering market research information. You are free to revoke your consent for the use of your data for these purposes at any time in writing.

Extensive technical and organisational security measures are in place, which safeguard the best possible protection of your data from unauthorised access and misuse. These measures are regularly checked and upgraded to meet the latest technological standards.

Your personal data are forwarded to the relevant online registrars in order to register your domains (e.g. DENIC) and to other service providers (e.g. banks) in accordance with the regulations of the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) to the extent that the information is necessary to fulfil the contract. Your data will be available to the public upon request on WHOIS domain lookups in varying forms. The extent of the data submitted is always restricted to the absolute minimum information required.

Keyweb AG is only allowed to pass personal information to authorities and third parties in accordance with statutory provisions or following a court order (e.g. for law enforcement purposes). Third parties will only be given information if a legal provision explicitly demands this. This may be the case, for instance where copyright has been infringed.

Keyweb AG will not sell your data to third parties!

Under the Federal Data Protection Act you have the right to access your stored personal data, have it corrected, blocked or deleted at any given time. Should the requested deletion of your data not be possible for the reasons outlined below, your data will instead be blocked. Possible reasons that make a deletion impossible are legal, contractual, trading or fiscal retention periods.
